




## Executive Surmary

PALS is Pakistan's only water safety, drowning prevention and rescue authority. We create a safe environment on Karachi's beaches and coastline through patrols, education, training, public safety campaigns and the promotion of health and fitness.

PALS was born out of a necessity – a necessity to safeguard and protect the lives of all the beach going population of Pakistan. Prior to our inception in 2004, there used to be on average 250+ cases of drowning every year along the beaches of Karachi. PALS has been able to contain this drowning rate to 'near zero' since 2004 to date.

## **INTERNATIONAL AFFILIATIONS**& SUPPORT

PALS Rescue is an internationally accredited lifeguarding establishment, representing Pakistan in the International Life Saving Federation (ILS) as a Full Member. PALS is also closely associated with Surf Life Saving New Zealand (SLSNZ), who have an on-going 'training and assisting' program with it. PALS has recently also been given membership at the Royal Lifesaving Society (RLSS). The initial training and certification of PALS was conducted by SLSNZ who certified 200 lifeguards in accordance with international standards. SLSNZ delegations usually visit PALS on a yearly basis to conduct refresher lifeguard and first aid training courses.


Karachi is the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest city in the world by population and 20<sup>th</sup> largest by area. With a population of 20 million, over 8 million people visit Karachi's beaches every year. Due to an acute lack of swimming facilities in the country, hardly anyone knows how to swim. As a result, every year 250 people used to lose their lives along the 40 km's of Karachi's public beaches. To control this high drowning rate, PALS Rescue was created in 2004 and almost instantly, brought down this rate to 'near zero'.

This proposal seeks the continuation of assistance of the Sindh Government to partner with PALS Rescue, for it to continue providing free public safety to the masses along the beaches of Karachi and beyond (we are planning to expand our services and operations to the popular lakes/aquatic environments in interior Sindh). This proposal seeks financial assistance for the year 2023–2024,

### Goal: Helping Save Lives.

With the assistance of the Sindh Government, over the next 5 years, PALS will accomplish the following:

- We shall save over 10,000 lives.
- Over 10,000,000 <u>Preventive Actions</u> will be conducted that ensure safety of the beach visitors.
- Over 100,000 First Aid treatments (jelly fish stings, cuts, etc) will be conducted.
- Will <u>protect</u> in excess of 8 million beach visitors per year.
- Will employ between 250-300 lifeguards which play a major role in uplifting the local village economies.


- Over 8 million people visit the beaches of Karachi throughout the year.
- The total public beach stretch of Karachi is 40 Km from Sea View to Mubarak Village
- There were no life guards for the protection of the public along the 40 km beach stretch of Karachi (prior to PALS deploying 200 lifeguards since July 18, 2004).
- There were over 250 drowning in Karachi beaches every year.
- Average age of drowning victims is 18.
- All PALS lifeguards come in close contact with the general public every day. This means general communication, beach awareness, hazard discussions, real live rescue witnesses, etc.
- PALS lifeguards are trained and certified by New Zealand Life Guards (SLSNZ) and are up to par with international standards.
- PALS has all the necessary equipment for effective near shore rescues.
- The Grant will provide an excellent platform for the Sindh Government to support a much needed social service in addition to co-brand on all life guard uniforms, towers, safety sign boards, etc.
- The assistance from the Sindh Government will help PALS continue its poverty alleviation drive along the coastal belt of Karachi and Sindh.
- The assistance will also help PALS implement its plans to secure multiple revenue streams over the next 5 years, so that long term continuity of the free public safety service is ensured, thanks to the Sindh Government.
